



Austrian-Canadian Essay Award 2011

The **Austrian-Canadian Society** (www.austria-canada.com) is pleased to announce the opening of the competition for the fourth annual *Scientific Award of the Austrian-Canadian Society*. The Award will be presented to the author of the best essay in the area of Canadian Studies, and will ideally be relevant to the study of Austria as well. The Society aims to be a key forum for bilateral exchange and cooperation, and looks to deepen the ties between Austria and Canada. The recipient of the Award will be selected by a scientific selection committee and will be announced by the Canadian Ambassador in Vienna, Austria in December of this year. The *Scientific Award of the Austrian-Canadian Society* is accompanied by a prize of 1000 Euros, and the publication of the essay on the Austrian-Canadian Society's website. We seek submissions from Austrian or Canadian students at the undergraduate or graduate level, but students of other nationalities will not be excluded. Ideally, essays will include some comparison with/or consideration of Austrian material. Essays may fall into the following categories, broadly defined:

Law and Economy
Political Science and Sociology
Literature and Linguistics
History and Geography

Requirements:

Essays may be written in German, French or English and should be a minimum of 25 pages. Essays should not have been previously published at the time of submission. Publication of the paper after receiving the award is possible. Submissions must be received (together with an attached C.V. and statement that the essay has not been previously published) by **Friday, December 5, 2011**.
